PAW PAW—Frank C. Thompson Jr., 48, former Paw Paw village president and well-known funeral director, died Sunday morning at his funeral home, 413 East Michigan avenue.

He was born March 13, 1916, in Lawrence. His parents were Mr. and Mrs. Frank Thompson Sr.

Mr. Thompson attended Kalamazoo College and graduated from Wayne State University. He was a member of the Michigan Municipal Retirement Board, Paw Paw American Legion Post, Paw Paw Masonic Lodge 25 and a past commander of McKinley-Wilson Veterans of Foreign Wars Post in Paw Paw.

He was a veteran of World War II.

Survivors include his wife, Florence; three sons, Frank II, a student at Delfon College in Midland, David of Paw Paw, and Waite of Los Angeles, Calif.; two daughters, Barbara and Linda of Paw Paw; his parents; a brother, Dr. James Thompson of Tulsa, Okla., and a sister, Mrs. John Yoworsky of Willmette, Ill.

The body was taken to the Thompson Funeral Home where friends may call after 7 p. m. today until 4 p. m. Tuesday, when his body will be taken to the Thompson residence.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday at 2 p. m. in the Paw Paw Presbyterian church with the Rev. Konrad Kaltenbach, pastor, officiating.

Burial will be in Prospect Hill cemetery with military rites at the grave.
